"If a Bidder (either an individual Firm or Lead Member of a Consortium) is having a minimum Net-Worth of Rs.100 Crores as on 31st March 2011, then such a Bidder shall be exempt from meeting/qualifying the Experience Criteria for qualification/eligibility.

Notwithstanding anything contained in this sub clause 3.5.7, this High Net worth criteria and the corresponding exemption from qualifying the Experience Criteria shall be applicable only for the Bidders who have constructed/ developed projects in infrastructure sectors as defined by the Planning Commission of India amounting to total value of 25 Crores in maximum three Projects in the last five financial years (FY 2010-11, 2009-10, 2008-09, 2007-08 and 2006-07). The notification issued by Planning Commission on Definition of Infrastructure is annexed to this Section as Annexure I. "
